



## Smartphone instructions for T-Mobile DASH

### Enabling Bluetooth on UME36:

1. From the main menu, select “Services” => “Admin Settings” and enter password “ADMIN333” and choose F3 to confirm.
2. Choose “Connectivity” => “Bluetooth Support”, and check “Use Bluetooth Dongle”. Select right arrow to save settings. (Please note Bluetooth supported in Application versions 1.0.3.4 ST and higher)
3. Insert Bluetooth Dongle in “USB Ext.” port on top of the UME36.

### Enabling Bluetooth on the DASH:<sup>1</sup>

1. On the main menu of the phone, open “Start” => “Settings”
2. Open the “Connections” tab, then “Bluetooth” and change to “Visible” by pressing the right directional twice.
3. Click left soft key for ‘Done’

### Transferring Phonebook to the DASH:

1. Select Source and Target phone as normal. Model will be “T-Mobile”=> “DASH” in the menu. Select phone as target memory, and press “>” key.
2. Start the transfer, select the “>” arrow on UME36 when prompted to upload the Client. Choose “>” arrow again when prompted to activate Bluetooth.
3. UME36 will detect all Bluetooth devices within range. Select “T-Mobile Dash” in the menu and click OK.
4. Dash will prompt to pair with UME36, click “Yes” on Dash, enter pin code 0000 and click next.<sup>2</sup>
5. Finish adding the UME36 as a Bluetooth device by accepting all prompts on the Dash.
6. Click “>” arrow on UME36 when prompted to finish adding the UME as a new Bluetooth device.
7. UME36 will upload client ‘cellebrite.exe’, click “yes” on Dash when prompted to accept.
8. To start the client from the main menu of the Dash, select “Start” => “File Explorer” and open the “cellebrite.exe”
9. Select “yes” to confirm unknown publisher.
10. Select “>” arrow twice on the UME36 to finish transferring the phonebook.
